Music Director Laura Ahumada will gather a group of outstanding pianists, violinists and percussionists to teach music. Multimedia artist Sujin Lee returns for a week of intensive art. Other activities include tennis, dance and movement, art and sculpture, and Spanish. For the over-sixes, activities include chess and soroban, and for the nines and up, digital imaging, digital music, filmmaking and web site development. *

For two year old children, the Toddler Summer Program will follow the routine and schedule that the Toddler program follows during the regular school year. The curriculum includes music, language and outdoor play.

No matter what the activity, the emphasis will be on fun. And, as long as the children are having fun, the learning will take place.
